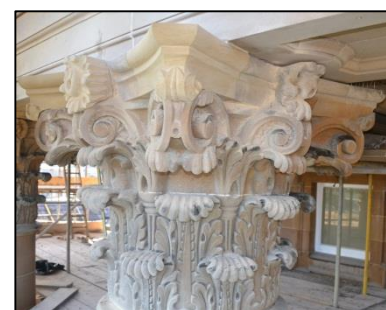




RENFREWSHIRE COUNCIL PAISLEY TOWN HALL REFURBISHMENT
