

LECTURE THEATRE PROJECTS

Sir Charles Wilson Lecture Theatre, University of Glasgow

Conversion of the existing listed church building to form a lecture theatre and teaching accommodation. The works included extensive repair of the existing building fabric, including asbestos removal works, roof and masonry repairs, refurbishment of existing stained glass windows, structural alterations, electrical, audio visual and mechanical ventilation installations, provision of new toilet accommodation and fire escape stairs, together with associated fittings, finishings and external works. The project cost was £2,025,000.





Modern Languages Lecture Theatre, University of Glasgow

The works comprised the refurbishment of and alteration to the existing lecture theatre to provide seating for 205 students. The works included strip out works, asbestos removal, new roof coverings, heating and ventilation replacement, new electrics and lighting, new seating, wall, floor and ceiling finishes, acoustic linings, new lectern and audio visual equipment. The project cost was £300,000.

Western Infirmary Lecture Theatre, University of Glasgow

The University employed us as Quantity Surveyors on the £900,000 extension and internal alterations to the existing WILT building to provide larger teaching accommodation including services and external works. The existing lecture theatre was enlarged and upgraded and additional seminar rooms added.





Gloag Lecture Theatre, University of Glasgow

We provided Quantity Surveying Services for the refurbishment of the existing lecture theatre including the replacement of tiered seating and lectern together with new finishes and mechanical and electrical services. The contract value for this project was £80,000.

Davidson Building Lecture Theatre, University of Glasgow

The works comprised the refurbishment and alteration of the existing lecture theatre including strip out, repair of existing copper roof coverings, installation of structural supports and the construction of a new plantroom floor, lining of existing walls, renewal of floor, wall and ceiling finishes, renewal of mechanical, ventilation, and electrical installations, including associated builders work, and redecoration. The project value was £325,000.







Kelvin Building Lecture Theatre L312, University of Glasgow

The works comprised the refurbishment of and alteration to the existing lecture theatre to provide seating for 150 students. The works included strip out works, asbestos removal, heating and ventilation replacement, new electrics and lighting, external door and window replacement, new seating, wall, floor and ceiling finishes, new lectern and audio visual equipment. The project value was £200,000.
